
And there were personal challenges such as health, loved ones, death,







Key #4 | Listen to Learn. Pay attention to instructions, especially when you don't fully understand

Key #5 | "Stand in the water." Put yourself in position to take action

Joshua 3:8, You shall command the priests who bear the ark of the covenant, saying, 'When you have come to the edge of the water of the Jordan, you shall stand in the Jordan.'

When the people gathered to cross over, before the waters receded, God commanded the leaders to stand in the edge of the water.

It was a indication of obedience and commitment to act. It is like making a pledge to our Building His Kingdom, building fund.



Key #6 | When you change, your circumstances will change

13 And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests who bear the ark of the Lord, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of the Jordan, that the waters of the Jordan shall be cut off, the waters that come down from upstream, and they shall stand as a heap."



Key #7 | You don't have to see or understand everything that helps you

The waters of a Jordan was stopped out of view of the people. This was not like the Red Sea where are the people saw the waters divide and stack up. I don't know why God didn't let the people see how he did it, they only saw the result of it.

Some people have not gotten a vaccination because they don't understand it. Fear and hesitance sometimes keeps us from experiencing help. That's why we have been saying have faith in God and confidence in experts.

It's difficult when everyone makes them self an expert.
