What is Comfort?

Definition: παράκλησις paraklēsis

A calling to one's side, summons (esp. for help), supplication, entreaty, exhortation, admonition, encouragement

consolation, comfort, solace; that which affords refreshment

Matthew 14:14, And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick. 15 When it was evening, His disciples came to Him, saying, "This is a deserted place, and the hour is already late. Send the multitudes away, that they may go into the villages and buy themselves food."

Compassion Requires and Builds Courage

Jesus commanded His disciples to feed the people. Their reaction showed apprehension and fear.
