Romans 8:29

For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. 30 Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.

Romans 8:29 (New Living Translation)

For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son, so that his Son would be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. 30 And having chosen them, he called them to come to him. And having called them, he gave them right standing with himself. And having given them right standing, he gave them his glory.

Predestined

Predestination is not universal salvation which teaches that every one will be redeemed and no one will be eternally lost.

Nor is it "irresistible grace" in which people will be saved regardless of their willingness

Nor is it Calvinism (John Calvin) which asserts:

At the beginning of time, God selected a limited number of souls to grant salvation and there's nothing any individual person can do during their mortal life to alter their eternal fate. Either you were chosen or you were not chosen, and that's all there is to it.

Calvinism was compatible with slavery.

Calvinists maintained that enslaving non-Christian Africans was beneficial for them since they became exposed to "Christianity."

The truth is God knows who will be saved because He knows all things. It is not our place to make any assumptions about who will be saved, but to reach everyone.


Called – Conviction of the Holy Spirit from hearing the Gospel of Christ

Justified - Being made righteous through the new birth upon receiving Jesus as Lord.

Glorified - By God's grace, presence and training, growing and becoming more mature and fruitful

1 Corinthians 1:29

That no flesh should glory in His presence. 30 But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption—31 that, as it is written, "He who glories, let him glory in the Lord."



Look at the Circumstances and Connections in Acts 18

Acts 18:1 After these things Paul departed from Athens and went to Corinth. 2 And he found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, who had recently come from Italy with his wife Priscilla (because Claudius had commanded all the Jews to depart from Rome); and he came to them. 3 So, because he was of the same trade, he stayed with them and worked; for by occupation they were tentmakers. 4 And he reasoned in the synagogue every Sabbath, and persuaded both Jews and Greeks.
