






Knowing who you are is foundational to both a healthy self-image and a strong sense of purpose.




Likeness

Hebrew אַזיק - demût (pronounced, dem-ooth')

Stong's dictionary word (#H1819); means, resemblance; shape; like (-ness), manner, similitude.

This is best understood as representing the likeness or appearance of something or someone.







James 3:8 But no man can tame the tongue. It is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. 9 With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude [or likeness] of God

People maintain the image of God even in a broken or distorted form. People are redeemable and worth redeeming.

Without imago Dei, God would have had no reason to send His Son to die on our behalf.
