
#### 2 Corinthians 9:8

God provides what we need to IMPORT, to produce breakthrough in our lives.

God also gives us grace to **EXPORT** breakthrough for others.

1. The action of a lever.



- 1. The action of a lever. The mechanical advantage of a lever.
- 2. To use something that you already have in order to achieve something new or better
- 3. Power to influence people and get the results you want

- 4. In finance, the act of using borrowed money to buy an investment or a company
- 5. The power to influence results
- 6. In transactional relationships: Many people say it's not what you know, it is who you know. Others say it's not who you know, it's who knows you.

- 6. **Utility Leverage:** Using relationships to get things done. Asks the question: "How can I use you to get things I want?"
- 7. Value Leverage: Using relationships to increase your value in the eyes of others.

  Asks the question: "How can you make me look good?"

## The problem with this approach:

If one cannot provide utility or value, there is no relationship. Sometimes people have no use for people, so they are cast aside or ignored.

#### WHAT WE NEED!

#### There is the KINGDOM LEVERAGE

- Relationships rooted in Christ, not based personal advantage
- Asks the question, "How are you doing?" "How may I serve you?"
- What can I do to make another's life easier and more full of purpose
