Value/Treasure defined: The worth, importance, or usefulness of something. The verb is defined as: to rate something according to its perceived worth, importance, or usefulness.

Priority/Pearl defined: 1. The state of having most importance or urgency, 2. Somebody or something that is ranked highly in terms of importance or urgency, 3. The state of having preceded something else.

Value of Learning and Discovery

One great lesson of the parable is the **joy of the discovery** that caused the man to be willing to give up everything to make the treasure, and the expectation of discovery his own.

Matthew 13:44-46, Again, The kingdom of heaven is like something precious buried in a field, which a man found and hid again; **then in his joy he goes and sells all he has and buys that field.**

Don't Be Another "Hedonist"

Hedonism refers to a family of theories, all of which have in common that pleasure plays a central role in them. Psychological or motivational hedonism claims that human behavior is determined by desires to increase pleasure and to decrease pain.

This is contrary to the principle of following Christ and God's kingdom. "Seek first the Kingdom and His righteousness."

Pleasure and gratification are not the main thing. In fact, denying yourself and embracing pain is part of the purpose.
