Mark 12:30

What is the Mind of Christ?

1 Corinthians 2:14, But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. 15 But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one. 16 For "Who has known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct Him?" But we have the mind of Christ.


Paul identifies two kinds of people. Locate yourself:

There is the person who is *pneumatikos*.

Pneuma is the word for Spirit. The person who is *pneumatikos* is sensitive to the Spirit and whose life is guided by the Spirit.

There is the person who is *psuchikos*. He lives as if there was nothing beyond physical life and there were no needs other than material needs, whose values are all physical and material.
