## Romans 6:4

Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that **just as Christ was raised** from the dead by the glory of the Father, **even so we also should WALK in newness of life.** 5 For if we have been united together in the **likeness of His death**, certainly we also shall be in the **likeness of His resurrection.**

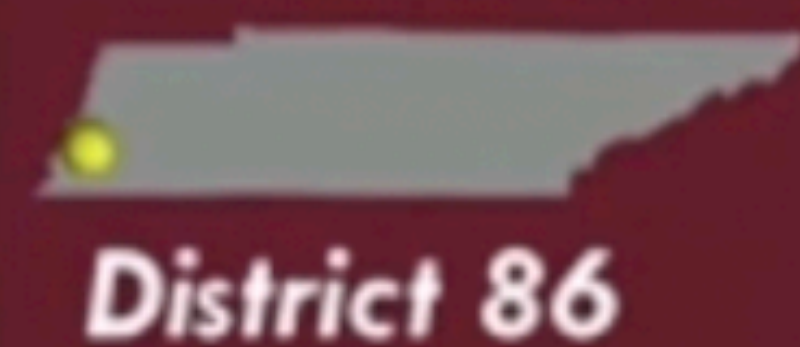

Greek word for verb “to walk”, *peripateō*:  
*“To make one's way, progress; to make due  
use of opportunities”*

The Hebrew equivalent of the word  
means, *“To live, to regulate one's life, to  
conduct one's self”*

In the new state (of life) in which the Holy Spirit places us,

Stands for the new life of the quickened spirit of the believer, from the operation of the Holy Spirit, by whose power the service is rendered.
