A **conviction** is a firmly held belief that motivates one to action. Convictions are like **ethics**, which are a developed system of beliefs and personal standards.

1 Thessalonians 1:5 (NASB), For our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; (KJV, assurance) just as you know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.

#1 - A conviction that God has placed them where they are serving.

Psalm 92:12, The righteous will flourish like a palm tree, they will grow like a cedar of Lebanon; 13 **planted in the house of the Lord**, they will flourish in the courts of our God. 14 They will still bear fruit in old age, they will stay fresh and green,

#2 - A conviction that places Christ and His people as a high priority. God made a promise to his people.

#3 - A willingness to accept any assignment necessary to advance the team's overall vision.

#5 - A conviction of faithfulness. Operating not just in sensation, but in season.

#6 - A conviction of availability: It has been said that availability is as important as ability.

Neil Maxwell wrote, "God does not begin by asking us about our ability, but only about our availability, and if we then prove our dependability, he will increase our capability"
