Genesis 1:14, Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night. And let them be for signs and for seasons, and for days and years,


Running Man Nebula (NGC 1977)


















THE HOLY SPIRIT IS OUR "AUTO-GUIDER"

WE NEVER NEED TO DRIFT

- 1. We DO NOT drift when paying attention to the Lord and His Word
- 2. We ALWAYS drift by not paying attention to the Lord and His Word
- 3. What are the consequences of drifting?

WHAT DRIFTING LOOKS LIKE

- 1. Low interest in the things of God
- 2. Higher interest in the things of the world (carnal minded)
- 3. Offense at direction and correction
- 4. "Low level" disobedience

STOP THE DRIFT

In many things, like driving, drifting can lead to accidents and damage.

When navigating, getting off course starts small but ends up diverging a long way off.

STOP THE DRIFT

Proverbs 10:17 (CEV)

Accept correction, and you will find life; reject correction, and you will miss the road.

HOW TO STOP THE DRIFT

- Give heed to what you have heard and learned
- Let QUALIFIED people help you: "As iron sharpens iron, so a friend sharpens a friend." (Proverbs 27:17, NLT)
- Colossians 3:16, Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly..."
- Philippians 4:13, I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

HOW TO STOP THE DRIFT

- Hebrews 10:25, Not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.
