



There are four keys to this transfer

1. ***It is a transference from darkness to light.***
Without God men grope and stumble as if walking in the dark. They know not what to do; they know not where they are going. God has given us a light by which to live and by which to die.
2. ***It is a transference from slavery to freedom.*** In Jesus Christ there is liberation.

There are four keys to this transfer

3. ***It is a transference from condemnation to forgiveness.*** He knows now that he is no longer a condemned criminal at God's judgment seat, but a lost son for whom the way home is always open.
4. ***It is a transference from the power of Satan to the power of God.*** Through Jesus Christ man is liberated from the grip of Satan and is able to become a citizen of the Kingdom of God.
