Notice what causes joy in Heaven...

Luke 15:7 CEB

7 In the same way, I tell you, **there will be more joy in heaven** over one sinner who changes both heart and life than over ninety-nine righteous people who have no need to change their hearts and lives.

One of the things that we see over and over in the New Testament is **Jesus' focus on the ONE**.

He saw the crowds, but Jesus focused on the individuals within the crowds.

He focused on the persons who made up the masses.

Compassion is Love in Action

Matthew 9:36 But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. 37 Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. 38 Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

Two Realities in a World of Illusions:

- 1) God sees persons, cares about persons, and loves persons. He knows each one by name.
- 2) He wants you to be the one who reaches the one. He wants you and me to see people, care for people, and love people

#1 Looking for the lost sheep

Luke 15:3-5 CEB

Jesus told them this parable: "Suppose someone among you had one hundred sheep and lost one of them. Wouldn't he leave the other ninety-nine in the pasture and search for the lost one until he finds it?"

#1 Woman with a blood disorder

Mark 5:25-34 Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years, 26 and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse. 27 When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. 28 For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well."

#2 Woman with a blood disorder

Mark 5:29 Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction. 30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, "Who touched My clothes?" 31 But His disciples said to Him, "You see the multitude thronging You, and You say, 'Who touched Me?'"

#2 Woman with a blood disorder

Mark 5:32, And He looked around to see her who had done this thing. 33 But the woman, fearing and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth. 34 And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction."

#3 Blind Bartimaeus

Mark 10:46 Now they came to Jericho. As He went out of Jericho with His disciples and a great multitude, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the road begging. 47 And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"48 Then many warned him to be quiet; but he cried out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!"

Mark 10:49

"So Jesus stood still..."

#3 Blind Bartimaeus

Mark 10:49 So Jesus stood still and commanded him to be called. Then they called the blind man, saying to him, "Be of good cheer. Rise, He is calling you."50 And throwing aside his garment, he rose and came to Jesus. 51 So Jesus answered and said to him, "What do you want Me to do for you?"The blind man said to Him, "Rabboni, that I may receive my sight." 52 Then Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your faith has made you well."

Over and over again Jesus challenges us to: Be THE ONE who sees THE ONE.

Do people have to "deserve" our attention or do we love unconditionally as Jesus loved?

- We need to ask God for the gift to see people.
- Not just look at people, but to actually see people.
- Seeing people, not only from our perspective, but in their reality.
